• Students are also exposed to the community learning during the field

postings where they get an insight into the community needs, culture, values etc.

- Students and interns posted in batches of 30 students to UHTC and RHTC throughout the year, transport facility is also provided (College bus) to these centers.
- Other community extension activities include Diagnostic camps, Blood Donation camps, Dental checkup camps, Cancer awareness and early detection, Malnutrition child development programmes and the national health programmes like RNTCP, NPCB, MCH, Immunization and pulse polio etc.
- The rural and urban community field posting, health centers and various camps helps in the community oriented education including health education, prevention and management of diseases.
- Students are also encouraged to take up short term ICMR projects for community research.
