


SMARA - QUIZ for Medical Students

Suspecting an outbreak of Cholera, detailed information regarding the locality and required information was collected. Following the instructions by Dickeyashree S. Seva, Professor and Head, Department of Community Medicine, Dr Venita V and Deekshith SCN along with District and PHC Rapid response team conducted a detailed house to home survey, collected the suspected samples, mapped the cases using GPS co-ordinates and completed the investigation successfully.

INAUGURATION OF URBAN HEALTH TRAINING CENTRE (UHTC), GUDIMAVU

UHTC at Gudimavu village near Kumbalgodu started functioning from 19th June, 2018 – Tuesday. The centre was inaugurated and blessed by his holiness Sri Sri Nirmalanandarathamahaswamiji and Reverend Sri Prakashanatha Swamiji around 10:30 am on 19th June, 2018. Dr. M. E. Mohan, Principal, BGS GIMS felicitated the Swamijis. The event was also graced by Dr. Ramachandra, Medical Superintendent; Dr. Shrikant, Deputy Medical Superintendent; Dr. Omprakash, Administrative Medical Officer, BGS GIMS; specialists from different Departments of BGS GIMS like OBG, Paediatrics, Orthopaedics; Nursing Superintendent, BGS GIMS and also the interns posted in the Dept. of Community Medicine. Our department was a part of Leprosy case detection campaign (LCDC) an initiative under National leprosy eradication programme in association with Uttaraballi PHC and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. The activity was conducted from 22nd October to 4th November 2018 for prevention of Leprosy in Urban areas. Dr Venkata V, Assistant Professor was the Nodal officer from the Department. Interns and 3rd term students were involved as volunteers. House to house search activity for leprosy cases was done by the volunteers along with health education regarding leprosy for a period of 14 days between 7.00am to 10.00am. Everyday 25-30 houses per team was covered. Total number of houses visited by volunteers was 14,806; total number of persons examined was 61,988. 24 cases were suspected to have leprosy and referred to the PHC for further confirmation. The activity was a success and positive feedback was given by Medical officer, Dr Sudha.


3. Street play/Role play for general public
